

“Good Handyman”

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The “Good Handyman” project ensures funds for regular investment maintenance of all facilities in which we look after our children and young people, as well as auxiliary facilities in our SOS Children’s Villages Lekenik and Ladimirevci used by our child development and administrative staff. We are obliged to ensure appropriate maintenance for more than fifty facilities housing SOS mothers with children, young people with their educators, SOS aunts and other child development staff that stays in Villages overnight for the purposes of replacing absent colleagues, or attending on-the-job training courses, seminars and other events. In addition to SOS families, a certain number of our expert co-workers also live in our Villages: depending on the location, our Villages serve as home to directors, pedagogical assistants and Village handymen.

Village handymen are an important part of the flawless operation of our Villages: in addition to maintaining facilities and grounds, carrying out repairs and installations, all of our handymen are also role models to children, teaching them skills that all children will need once they start living on their own. Our handymen also drive our official vehicles to transport children to excursions, vacations, swimming pools and sledding expeditions. They drive vans to transport donations in kind given to us by donors who are unable to deliver them themselves or to carry out major purchases and shopping for Village celebrations and festivities.

TARGET GROUP

Two hundred thirty-two children and young people from SOS Children’s Villages Ladimirevci and Lekenik
Financial guidelines of the project

HRK 25.000 annually for regular investment maintenance costs in all four SOS Youth Facilities – in Osijek, Velika Gorica and Zagreb;

HRK 40.000 annually for small repairs on installations in both SOS Children’s Villages – in Lekenik and Ladimirevci;

HRK 50.000 annually for costs of repairing appliances in both SOS Children’s Villages and in all four SOS Youth Facilities – in Osijek, Velika Gorica and Zagreb;

HRK 100.000 annually for average costs of maintaining all buildings and facilities in both SOS Children’s Villages – in Lekenik and Ladimirevci.

BENEFITS

FOR THE TARGET GROUP

This project is intended to ensure funds for regular investment maintenance of all facilities in both SOS Children’s Villages and all four SOS Youth Facilities, and for repairs on installations and appliances. At the same time, we enable children and youth to learn valuable skills that will be of use to them once they start living on their own: how to do small repairs around the house, how to change a bicycle tire or plant a favourite plant or a tree that will one day give them shade or even bear fruit.

FOR THE CORPORATE PARTNER


